LEAVING TOWN? POWER DOWN!

Heading out of town for the holidays? Save money and energy while you're away with just a few simple steps to make sure your home stays safe — and efficient.



Adjust your thermostat.

Set your thermostat to 55 - 60°F (or to Auto) to save energy while you're away. When you return, raise the temperature by only two degrees at a time to avoid activating auxiliary heat, which consumes more energy.



Unplug before you go.

Electronics and chargers still draw power when they're plugged in, even if they're turned off.



Turn off water heaters.

Switch to vacation mode or turn them off completely to avoid wasted energy.



Close blinds and curtains.

It keeps heat in during cool days and protects your home from prying eyes while you're gone.



Use smart plugs and timers.

Program a few lights to turn on in the evening for safety without running them all day.
